

GDPR Policy for Freediving and More

1. Introduction

At Freediving and More, we are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This statement outlines how we collect, use, store, and protect your personal data in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

2. Data Collection

We collect personal data for the purpose of providing safe and personalized diving experiences. This data may include:

- Full name
- Date of birth
- DNI, NIE or passport number
- Contact details (phone number, email address, address)
- Medical information relevant to diving
- Emergency contact details
- Diving certification details

3. Purpose of Data Collection

Your personal data is collected to:

- Ensure your safety and well-being during diving activities
- Comply with legal obligations and industry standards
- Communicate with you regarding your diving sessions, schedules, and updates
- Improve our services based on your feedback and preferences

4. Data Storage and Security

We implement strict security measures to protect your personal data from unauthorised access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction. Your data is stored securely and is only accessible to authorised personnel.

5. Data Sharing

We do not share your personal data with third parties except:

- When required by law or regulatory authorities
- To medical professionals in the event of an emergency
- With your consent, for specific purposes such as booking services with third-party providers

6. Data Retention

We retain your personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected or to comply with legal obligations. You may request the deletion of your data at any time, subject to legal requirements.

7. Your Rights

Under GDPR, you have the right to:

- Not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing
- To lodge a complaint with a Data Protection Authority (e.g., www.aepd.es)

- Access your personal data and request a copy
- Rectify any inaccurate or incomplete data
- Request the deletion of your personal data
- Restrict the processing of your data
- Object to the processing of your data
- Data portability (transfer your data to another service provider)

8. Consent

By providing your personal data and signing the consent form, you agree to the collection, use, and processing of your data as outlined in this statement. You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting us.
